Throughout the New Testament, Jesus often speaks of the “deeper things” in the context of a meal. During this Mission/Retreat we’ll take our seat at some of those tables, listening with the heart to the “seasonings” of Jesus’ wisdom – of searching, of healing, of forgiveness, of belonging, of loving.

Father Joerger invites not only the faithful but also all those who, for a whole variety of reasons, may not feel at home yet within our Catholic community but who are nevertheless spiritually hungry – disaffected Catholics, non-practicing spouses, neighbors from other faiths and those who do not regularly come to Church. All are welcome.

Father Joerger will be speaking at all the masses on the weekend of March 6th and 7th. The mission will begin on Monday, March 8th at 7:30PM. Father Joerger will celebrate the 9AM Mass each morning of the retreat.

FATHER ROBERT JOERGER, a native of Brooklyn, New York, is a member of the Passionist Community. Ordained in 1977, he received Masters Degrees in Theology and Divinity from Saint John's University, New York, and in Spirituality from Creighton University in Nebraska.

He also attended the Institute of Culinary Education and the French Culinary Institute in New York. Father Bob served as Director of Saint Gabriel's Retreat House for Youth on Shelter Island, New York, and as Provincial. He most recently served as Councilor to the Superior General of the Passionists in Rome. Currently Father Bob preaches Parish Missions and Retreats and lives in New York City.
